

# Instructions for I-DEEP Doctoral Researchers

How to **introduce your PhD research with a two-minute presentation** in the I-DEEP Annual event November 20, 2024.

All new doctoral researchers in the I-DEEP pilot are invited to present their research topic in two minutes.

Here are a few guidelines to help you prepare:

- **State your research focus clearly:** begin with a brief introduction to the main question or objective of your PhD. For example one or two sentences that capture the essence of your project to set the context for your audience
- **Explain the relevance and potential impact:** highlight **why** this topic matters. Consider how it fits into the broader field of photonics, particularly in terms of innovation and application
- **Highlight key methods or approaches:** if possible, mention the primary methods or approaches you will be using.
- **Keep it simple and accessible:** you are speaking to a diverse audience within the I-DEEP program, so try to use clear, non-technical language to keep everyone engaged.
- Practice your presentation beforehand to make sure you keep the 120 second limit
