


Welcome to Helsinki to the PREIN Workshop on Quantum Research and Technologies on 12–14 November 2024



Time zone

The time zone in Helsinki is Eastern European Time (EET), 2 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+2).













Climate and weather

Helsinki's climate in November reflects a combination of maritime and continental influences. Its proximity to the Arctic Ocean and the North Atlantic tends to bring colder temperatures, while the Gulf Stream can occasionally introduce milder air masses.

In November, you can expect the typical daily maximum temperature in Helsinki, Finland, to hover around -2 to 0 °C. However, it's important to keep in mind that temperatures can vary from year to year. Therefore, it's a good practice to consult a reliable weather forecasting source, such as. en.ilmatieteenlaitos.fi, closer to your travel dates for the most accurate and up-to-date weather information.



November in Helsinki is characterized by cold winter weather, often featuring sub-zero temperatures, snowfall, and frosty conditions, making it quite different from the milder months of the year.

Cultural Highlights

Helsinki is known for its vibrant cultural scene. The city boasts a variety of museums, art galleries, and theaters. A visit to the <u>Ateneum Art Museum</u> or the <u>Kiasma Museum of Contemporary Art</u> can provide a fascinating insight into Finnish art and culture.

2. MEETING VENUE

We have selected the Helsinki Congress Paasitorni, as the meeting venue. Paasitorni is located by the sea in the city center in close vicinity of the Hakaniemi marketplace and Hakaniemi metro station.



"Paasitorni" is an architecturally and culturally historically valuable meeting and congress center situated in Siltasaari, Helsinki. The oldest part of the Art Nouveau building, designed by architect Karl Lindahl, was completed in 1908 as the Helsinki Worker's House, and the building is still recognized by that name. For a long time, Paasitorni served as a meeting and leisure place for the working population, essentially functioning as a true worker's hall. Paasitorni is on the way to the World Heritage list. The meeting itself takes place in the meeting room Juho Rissanen. The Juho Rissanen room is characterful space whose special features include the stage at the front of the space – which also saw plenty of action during its heyday – and the paintings donated by the artist Juho Rissanen.

Allas Sea Pool

6. MEETING TRANSPORT INFORMATION

6.1 From <u>Helsinki Airport</u> to Helsinki centre

Taxi (2 options), ask for price confirmation before you accept the ride:

- <u>Airport Taxi</u> (price about 45 € to Helsinki centre); takes several passengers to the desired address and is somewhat slower (10–15 min) than normal taxi. The service desk of the taxi companies can be found in the arrival hall after baggage claim. If arriving late, it is advised to book in advance.
- Normal taxi: There is a taxi station in front of the terminal. All the major credit cards are accepted in the taxis. 20–30 min and price around 50-60 € to Helsinki centre.

Bus/Metro:

 Public transport ABC Single ticket on the HSL app, with the HSL card and at ticket machines, €4.10. The ticket is valid for 80 minutes. You can buy a ticket from the machine in the station, or R-kioski shops.

Train:

• From the <u>airport</u>, the centre of Helsinki can be reached by the I- or P-train (both directions would take you to the centre of Helsinki). To travel from the Airport to Helsinki city centre, you will need a ticket to <u>ABC zone</u> (and the ticket is also valid in the metro, trams or local busses). The ticket must be bought before the trip, for example from HSL ticket automates. The travel time is about 40 minutes to the railway station in the centre.
